The TEMPLEOGUE TELEGRAPH will be making a re-appearance in a Holiday Edition over the next 12 days at a price of 30p, and will be issued thereafter on a monthly basis. Door-to-door deliveries are being arranged.

The TEMPLEOGUE TELEGRAPH first appeared in November 1969 and, with one short break in 1971, continued in publication until March 1988. Over this 19-year period it was sponsored in turn by the Templeogue Youth Club (1969-71), the Templeogue Parents' Association (1971-77) and the Templeogue Community Council (1977-1988).

The attempt to keep the magazine going is a response to expressions of encouragement on all sides for publication to be resumed. It is interesting to learn that one of the most widely used resources to-day in the Terenure Library, particularly by students, is the file containing old copies the TEMPLEOGUE TELEGRAPH which are now becoming "collectors' items".

The New Year holiday edition will be on sale in the week immediately after Christmas. There will follow a January 1993 edition (on sale in the week commencing 17th January). The enterprise will be managed by Paddy Heneghan of 74 Templeville Drive (Tel.909128), who was involved in producing the magazine in its Youth Club days, during the period of the Templeogue Parents' Association sponsorship, and again during the period when the Community Council were taking over.

The general theme of the Holiday Edition will be "Memory Lane" and already a number of interesting items have been received from former contributors who have been willing to give the magazine a "kick start" on the way, hopefully, to its 21st birthday. The January edition will revive many of the old features, with news from local clubs, associations and schools, and a diary of events. Some space will be allotted as before to advertisements and particularly to small ads of a domestic nature at very reasonable rates.

The TEMPLEOGUE TELEGRAPH will be keeping in touch on an on-going basis with those who have contributed over the last few weeks. Pending developments, persons with material for publication can have it collected by leaving a message with Tel.909128.

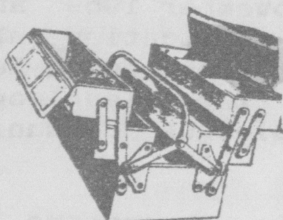
