Some of the achievements The Green Party have made in Government:

Providing Clean Green Energy



- Wind energy has doubled in the last three years and at times we are generating almost half of our energy from renewable sources.
- We have retrofitted almost 100k houses making peoples homes more comfortable and cheaper to heat.

Delivering Better Communications

• Broadband subscriptions have almost tripled and speeds have doubled under my watch. A recent Oxford University study places Ireland 13th in the world for leadership in broadband services.

Protecting our Children's Education

• Even in difficult economic times we have fought to protect key spending in primary and secondary education, and we have supported access to third level education for everybody.

Ending Bad Planning
